

Study on Livelihood system, traditional food system & food security assessment

Under CSIR-800 programme, a study was initiated on to assess the food accessibility and food security at BR Hills in collaboration with the involvement of AcSIR students. Accordingly, a preliminary visit was made on 24th January 2015. A questionnaire (both kannada/English) was prepared as per the guidelines of WHO. As per the interactions, it was decided to collect data with the minimum sample size of 100 across 10 hamlets.

General frameworks of the study include:

Traditional food habits, food diversity, Traditional foods of the region and its current status, How the RDIs are met, Accessibility food during various seasons, Govt. interventions in ensuring the food security, Market intervention, Emerging changes, Old Time Food Vs New food consumption, Change in health status and Policy perspective on food security.
